Faculty Academic Committees

AWARDS COMMITTEE

Responsibilities include:

- Identifying Alumni Faculty award recipients
- Nominating Who's Who candidates
- Selecting graduation response speaker

CHRISTIAN WORLDVIEW COMMITTEE

Responsibilities include:

- Enhancing integration of worldview in curriculum, student life, and spiritual development

FACULTY ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE

Responsibilities include:

- Coordinating faculty chapel, faculty retreat, and social activities

GENERAL EDUCATION CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

Responsibilities include:

- Initiating, reviewing, and recommending general education curriculum proposals
- Reviewing and enhancing General Education ePortfolio activities

STANDARDS AND EVALUATION COMMITTEE

Responsibilities include:

- Reviewing and recommending changes to academic policies, evaluation standards, and graduation requirements

UNIVERSITY RESEARCH COMMITTEE

Responsibilities include:

- Reviewing and recommending research proposals through the Intramural Grant program

Academic Department

Responsibilities include:

- Initiating and recommending general education proposals to the General Education Curriculum Committee
- Approving appropriate department-based changes

- Initiating and recommending school-based academic proposals to school curriculum committee

School Curriculum Committee

Responsibilities include:

- Approving appropriate school-based changes

- Recommending school-based academic proposals to school faculty

School Faculty Assembly

Responsibilities include:

- Approving appropriate school-based changes consistent with university academic outcomes

- Recommending major academic proposals to Faculty Senate

University Faculty Senate

Voting members include:

- School deans and faculty representatives from every academic department as defined in the *University Faculty Senate Bylaws*

Speaking, non-voting members include:

- Representatives from Registrar, Institutional Research, Information Technology, Athletics, and VPAA; University Technical Editor

Responsibilities of Faculty Senate include considering and recommending to university faculty proposals consistent with university academic outcomes concerning:

- Curriculum
- Graduation requirements
- Faculty appointment procedures
- Modifications to the catalog and *Faculty Handbook*

All University Faculty vote electronically on Faculty Senate recommendations following each Faculty Senate session

Faculty recommends proposals to the VPAA who recommends them to the Provost who approves appropriate changes and recommends policy change proposals to the President

Recommended policy change proposals require approval from the Board of Trustees

Faculty Professional Committees

All Faculty Professional Committees report directly to the
Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Any proposals concerning curriculum, graduation requirements, faculty appointment procedures, or modifications to the catalog or *Faculty Handbook* shall be recommended to the Faculty Senate for consideration.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

Responsibilities include:

- Mentoring faculty through the promotion and tenure process
- Acts as a resource for faculty training and development

HONORS PROGRAM COMMITTEE

Responsibilities include:

- Reviewing and recommending changes to the Honors program
- Planning Honors chapel and Honors reception
- Participating in extracurricular activities of the Honors program

SOTL-CHED EDITORIAL BOARD

Responsibilities include:

- Participating in the submission, reviewing, and publication process for the journal
- Promoting the journal among CCCU schools

UNIVERSITY TENURED FACULTY

Responsibilities include:

- Assessing fitness of candidates applying for tenure
- Participating when requested in the grievance and conflict resolution procedure

WAC COMMITTEE

Responsibilities include:

- Developing and recommending writing curriculum initiatives
- Identifying WAC award recipients
